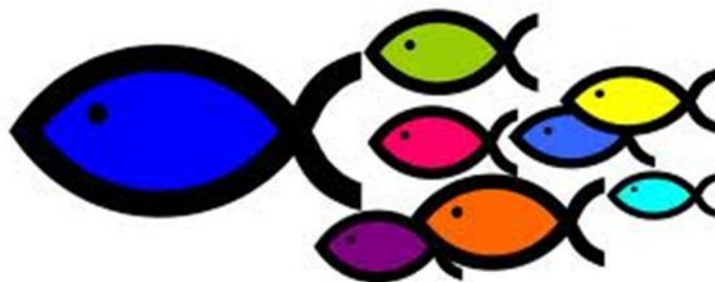
# School of Fish

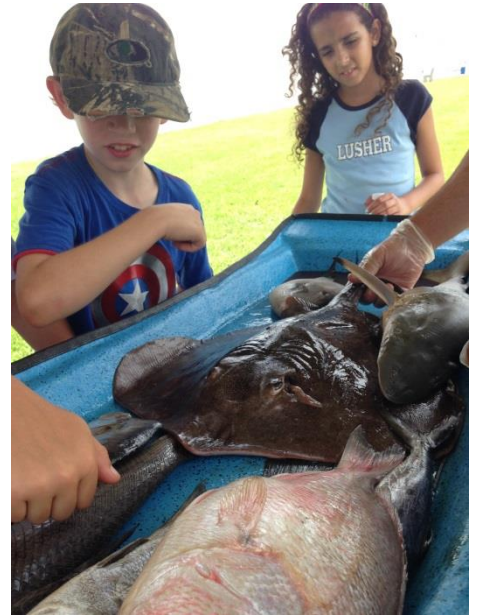
The John C. Burrus School of Fish program is a free half-day clinic for children ages 8 through 15. Held in June at LPBF's New Canal Lighthouse and the adjacent New Orleans Lakefront, children will learn about fish and how to catch them from our beautiful lake. We'll provide the lunch; you provide your life jacket! At the end of the program, students will receive a Certificate of Participation and LPBF's School of Fish t-shirt.



Stations will be set up to teach:

- Knot tying/Tackle
- Fish ID
- Casting
- Fishing with rods and reels
- Boating Safety
